## Student Satisfaction Survey 2019-20

A student satisfaction survey was conducted online using a Google Form. The opinions collected from the students on various aspects of the programme are analyzed to find their effectiveness as well as their shortcomings. The details of the analysis are summarised as follows:

1. The majority of the students ( $82.2 \%$ ) opined that 85 to 100 percent of the syllabuses are covered by the teachers in their respective courses; $15.1 \%$ opined that 70 to 85 percent are covered by the teachers; and the remaining students (less than 3\%) opined that the syllabus is covered less than 70 percent.
2. Sixty-two percent of the students opined that the teacher prepares thoroughly for teaching, and the remaining 32 percent opined that it is only at a satisfactory level.
3. The majority of the students $(88.8 \%)$ opined that the respective teachers communicate well with them; 11 percent rated their communication skills as only satisfactory, and the remaining rated them satisfactorily.
4. Sixty-eight percent of the students opined that the teacher's approach to teaching was excellent, 24 percent as very good, and the remaining rated it as good.
5. The majority of the students ( $78.9 \%$ ) rated the fairness of teachers in internal assessment and evaluation as always fair, and 16 percent rated it as usually fair.
6. Sixty percent of the students opined that feedback on their assignments is discussed by the teachers in the class; 34.2 percent rated it the same as usual, and 8 percent rated it the same as sometimes.
7. Forty-nine percent of the students opined that the institution makes regular efforts for the internship and exchange of students; 22.4 percent opined it as often; 19.1 percent rated it as sometimes; and the remaining as rarely.
8. Forty-four percent of the students opined that the teaching and mentoring process of the institution was very good, 44.1 percent as significant, and the remaining 12.5 percent as moderate.
9. Fifty-one percent of the students strongly agree that the institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow; 33.6 percent rated the same as agree, and the remaining 11.6 percent disagree.
10. Fifty-eight percent of the students opined that every time teachers inform students on expected competencies, course outcomes, and programme outcomes, 25.7 percent opined that teachers inform these usually, and the remaining mentioned that they say sometimes.
11. Fifty-four percent of the students opined that the mentor does necessary follow-up with the assigned task; 29.6 percent of them rated the same as usual, and 10.5 percent rated it as sometimes.
12. The majority of the students (67.8\%) opined that teachers illustrate the concept through examples and applications every time, 19.1 percent opined it is usually, and the remaining rated it as sometimes.
13. Sixty-three percent of the students agree that teachers help us identify our strengths and encourage us by providing the right level of challenges; 25.7 percent rate the same as reasonable and the remaining as partially.
14. Sixty percent of the students opined that teachers help them identify their weaknesses and overcome them every time; 21.1 percent of them rated the same as usual and the remaining as sometimes.
15. Fifty-six percent of the students strongly agree that the institution makes an effort to engage students in the monitoring, review, and continuous quality improvement of the teaching and learning process; 30.9 percent agree, and the remaining are neutral.
16. Fifty-nine percent of the students opined that teachers use student-centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning, and problem-solving methodologies, for enhancing learning experiences to a great extent; 25.7 percent rated the same as moderate, and the remaining rated the same as somewhat.
17. Sixty-four percent of the students strongly agree that teachers encourage them to participate in extracurricular activities; 25.7 percent agree the same; and the remaining are neutral.
18. Sixty-five percent of the students opined that teachers inculcate soft skills, life skills, and employability skills to make them ready for the world of work; the same is moderate to 19.1 percent, and the remaining rated the same as somewhat.
19. Twenty-eight percent of the students opined that above 90 percent of the teachers are using ICT tools in the class for ICT-integrated teaching; 33 percent opined that only 70 to 89 percent of the teachers are using ICT tools; and 20.4 percent opined 50 to 69 percent.
20. The majority of the students (69.1\%) strongly agree that the overall quality of the teachinglearning process of the institution is very good; it is agreed upon by 23 percent, and the remaining are neutral.
21. Some of the suggestions put forward by the students to improve are listed as follows by excluding positive comments: ICT-based teaching and learning process; need for more student-centric activities; library hours could be included in the timetable; need for internships and field activities; avoid partiality; more training for competitive examinations and placement opportunities; need for using ICT-integrated class-room activities for teaching and learning, especially projectors and modern gadgets for teaching and learning; try to boost the confidence level of the students to communicate in English fluently without any fear; and the need for campus interviews.
